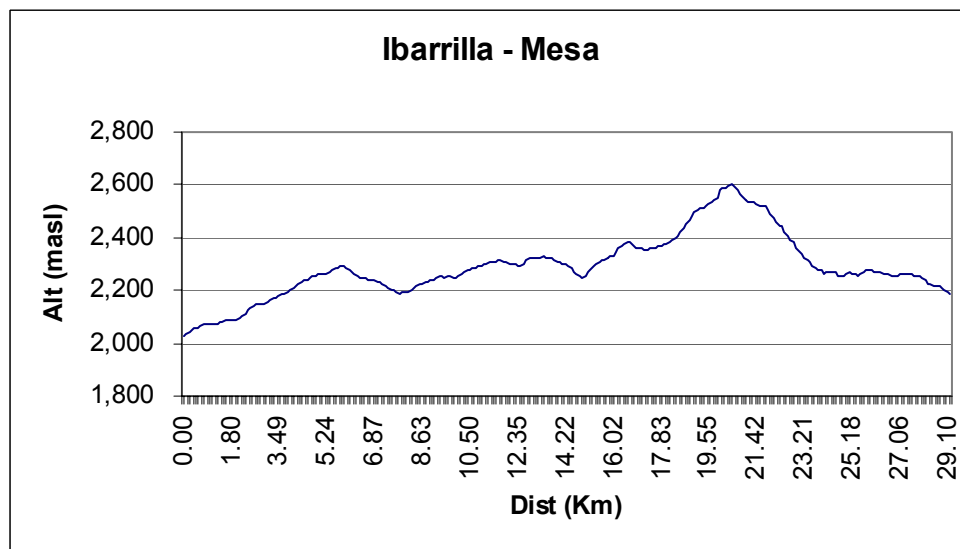


## STAGE DESCRIPTIONS & ELEVATION CHARTS LEG 3

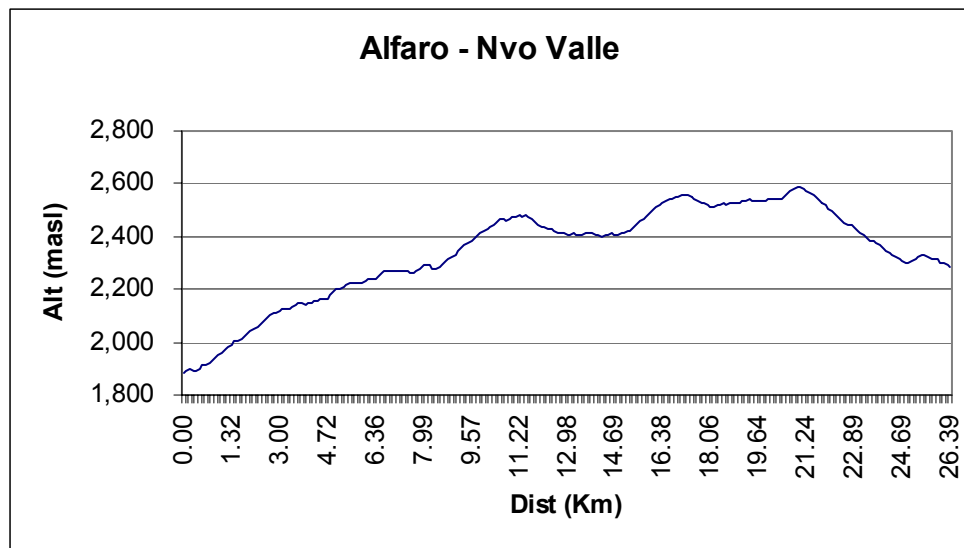
<b>SPECIAL STAGE 11/14 : IBARRILLA - MESA</b>	
<b>LENGTH:</b>	<b>30.47 km</b>
<b>STAGE RECORD:</b>	<b>20:48:5 Janusz Kulig - Mitsubishi Lancer Evolution GpN (2003)</b>

This is the longest stage of the rally and starts at 2,029 meters on narrow packed gravel roads. It begins with a fast uphill section before levelling out at 2,300 meters, climbing again on very fast open roads to 2,604 meters after 20.41 kilometers. A downhill sequence of bends, in open and spectacular scenery, take crews to a river crossing before climbing back up the mountain through a series of long corners. The road then narrows and goes onto twisty undulating sections, becoming technical down to the finish at 2,186 meters. The mean altitude of the stage is 2,289 meters.



<b>SPECIAL STAGE 12/15 : ALFARO - NUEVO VALLE</b>	
<b>LENGTH:</b>	<b>27.85 km</b>
<b>STAGE RECORD:</b>	<b>No record. The stage is the same as SS19/21 in 2003, but the finish has been extended by 2.21 km.</b>

The stage starts at 1,885 meters on a fairly wide fast road and winds its way up to 2,586 meters by 20.94 kilometers on flowing hard packed gravel roads. It is a technical stage, descending to the finish over a very fast section towards the town of Nuevo Valle de Moreno at 2,286 meters. The stage passes through the village of Alisos at 12.65 km and is one of the classics of Corona Rally México. The mean altitude of the stage is 2,342 meters.



<b>SPECIAL STAGE 13 : DERRAMADERO - COMANJILLA</b>	
<b>LENGTH:</b>	<b>15.42 km</b>
<b>STAGE RECORD:</b>	<b>9:54:5 Janusz Kulig - Mitsubishi Lancer Evolution GpN (2003)</b>

The stage starts at 2,349 meters on flowing open roads, peaking at 2,465 meters after 3.15 kilometers. The stage then flattens out in a very fast section before descending through a series of hairpins and flat-out sections to the finish in Comanjilla at 2,031 meters. The stage passes through the village of La Estancia at 9.60 km, and is the shortest but one of the fastest of the event. The mean altitude of the stage is 2,299 meters.
